

End of the Day Electives and Study Halls

Students will be able to participate in study halls and recess times throughout the day. For **fundamentals, foundations, and building on foundations**, these are written into the schedule. For **Next Steps**, it fully depends on the math they take. During Next Steps Math A there will be half an hour of study hall, followed by half an hour of recess. The schedule will repeat during Next Steps Math B. So, if taking Math A, your student's free time will be during Math B and vice versa. If your student is taking a Last Steps Math course, they will have a two hour block of study hall/recess during their off day. They also have a recess at the very end of the day. For **Last Steps**, given the nature of a high school schedule, students will be in Study Hall during any classes they do not take. They are welcome to go outside or remain inside during their breaks as long as they are responsible and make supervisors aware of their location.

Creative Building

Students are provided with multiple building mediums and materials and given the freedom to build and create.
